The Family Society will meet on Monday at 6:00pm at Our Lady of Lourdes. All are welcome!

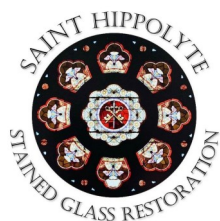

Should you receive an unsolicited request for money or personal information – including a request for gift cards of any type – exercise extreme caution. Contact the person or entity being impersonated by using official contact information only. Do not use contact information provided in the potential fraudulent request.
