



Help your child set up strong passwords and do a yearly checkup on them. Adjust privacy settings for online games, apps, social media sites and your child's electronic devices. Even as a priest, there is a desire to cling to the things of this world, with its comforts and honors, to cling to the comfortability that can come with attachments to disordered affections and sin. The priest has to be the man who stands in the midst of the people with whom God has blessed him to serve as the model of the mystery bearer. Father Barron in this interview continued, giving a practical example of how the priest is to live:

"To live a life of a mystery bearer is to make a commitment at the level of your behavior-your lifestyle and it involves those questions of celibacy and simplicity. It can't just be a disembodied intellectual exercise. It means I make a commitment of my life, and I'm going to live stubbornly in the presence of the mystery. That means attending to all that language about poverty and asceticism that the spiritual teachers insist upon."
