Eucharistic Eucharistic Revival St. Bridget of Sweden, who lived in the 14th century, had a great devotion to the Passion of Jesus and to His Precious Blood. Her parents brought her up devout in the Christian faith, and she married and had 8 children (one of whom became St. Catherine of Sweden, while some other children ignored the Church). When her

husband died, she founded her own religious order, known as the Brigittines, who have a devotion to the Passion of Jesus as their charism. Bridget had many mystical experiences of Jesus and His Passion, so many they are recorded in a book called "Revelations of St. Bridget of Sweden." St. Bridget's feast day is July 23.

Cemetery guidelines...It has come to our attention that several graves in the parish cemeteries are not in compliance with our cemetery regulations. In order that all are treated fairly, we ask that corrective measures be taken if your loved one's gravesite is out of compliance. Some problems that have been seen include: solar lights, plants in plastic pots rather than in the ground; decorative borders, mulch, and stones, etc. Bear in mind that decorative items fixed in the ground with a stake should be placed immediately in front of or beside the grave marker. Artificial flowers can only be displayed from November 1st to April 1st. Please remember that cemeteries are sacred ground and should be treated with the utmost respect. Also, please be mindful of the safety of those who mow and trim our grounds. Stay safe online: Mail display name spoofing Mail display name spoofing is a trick used by cybercriminals to make an email look like it's from someone you know or trust. They change the name that appears in the "From" field of the email, but the actual email address is different. For example, you might get an email that looks like it's from your boss, but the email address is not your boss's real address. This tactic is often used in phishing attacks to trick people into sharing sensitive information or clicking on malicious links. It's especially effective on mobile devices where you might only see the display name and not the full email address.
