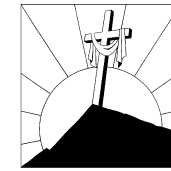

Virtues Explained!

“for the grace of God has appeared bringing salvation to the entire human race...(teaching) us to reject godless ways and worldly desires,,” reads Titus 2:11-12, “and in the present age to lead lives that are temperate, just and godly.” This cardinal virtue of temperance is shown in the person who is master of his passions and his attachment to the world. “It ensures the will’s mastery over instincts and keeps desires within the limits of what is honorable,” we read in the Catechism (CCC1809). Temperance is not repression of feeling; it is an exercise of the will, a careful and calculated choice. In this way, temperance actually safeguards virtuous live, keeping it “whole and uncorrupted,” said St. Augustin. The practice of temperance is intimately linked to the virtue of chastity, which “protects the intimate center of the person...refusing to unveil what should remain hidden” (CCC2521).
