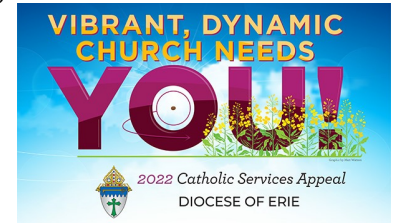

If you are following Matthew Kelly's **Best Lent Ever**, his theme this year is on Generosity. He says that generosity is contagious and that what we do lives on forever. One act of generosity spreads from person to person to person. How we treat a stranger or each other is a reflection on how we view our own self. Our best example of generosity is to follow how Jesus was so generous to everyone he met; he did not judge or condemn people, he accepted all no matter where they were from or how they lived or their ethnic background. Jesus teaches us that we are to be generous to all, not just our own friends or family. In fact, the more we reach out to others, the more we accept others is to be generous. The most generous act is praying for each other. Be generous with your affection and smile at everyone you meet no matter where you are, at church, at work, at a party, or a restaurant. Give something away every day, it doesn't need to be money or things but it can be just your love shown to someone you don't know, maybe someone from our own parish. If you don't know someone from the other church in our parish, then go to soup and bread and you can meet someone who just maybe needs to receive your gift of generosity. Ask yourself, "How am I going to show **GENEROSITY** this week?"
