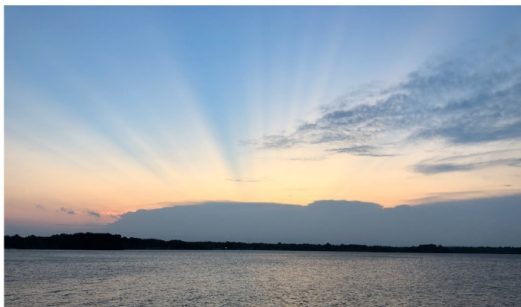

Always look for the parish's official phone number found on the diocesan website or in the parish's Sunday bulletin. In this age when personal data can be misused by scam artists, please be aware that the Roman Catholic Diocese of Erie, its clergy and entities such as parishes and schools will never solicit your personal or business information by any method unless initiated by you. Should you receive an unsolicited request for money or personal information — including a request for gift cards of any type — exercise extreme caution. Stay safe online: Mail display name spoofing is a trick used by cybercriminals to make an email look like it's from someone you know or trust. They change the name that appears in the "From" field of the email, but the actual email address is different. For example, you might get an email that looks like it's from your boss, but the email address is not your boss's real address. This tactic is often used in phishing attacks to trick people into sharing sensitive information or clicking on malicious links. It's especially effective on mobile devices where you might only see the display name and not the full email address.

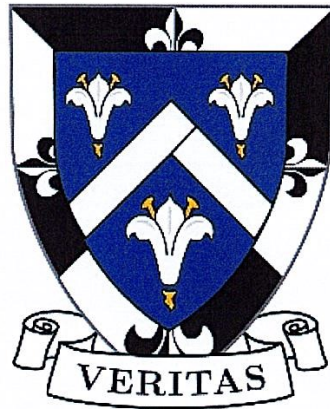
