Eucharistic Revival Today is Candlemas, or the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple, and the purification of the Virgin Mary. Today we bless candles as a symbol of the Light of the World coming into the Temple, the *"light to reveal you to the nations."* If we keep Jesus as our light, He will show us the quickest

and surest way to our Father. That means we have to follow what He says. "*I give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.*" Mt. 16:19, and *"Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life"* Jn. 6:54. These are the sacraments of Confession and Communion. We are not so entitled to Communion that we can receive it without Confession of mortal sins as well.
