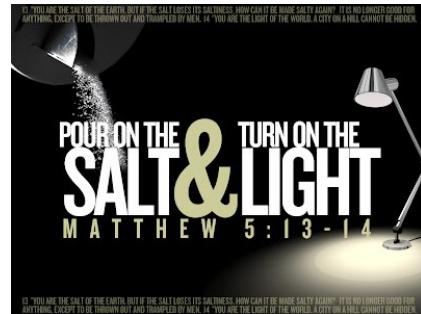

For many years our parish has participated in the *Super Bowl for Caring* on Super Bowl Sunday. Our collection will take place following the Masses on Sunday, February 12, Super Bowl Sunday. 100% of your donations will then be given to the Meadville Area Soup Kitchen, located at Stone United Methodist Church in Meadville.






First envisioned in 1990, the *Souper Bowl of Caring* has overseen the collection of over \$170 million in dollars and canned food, supporting thousands of soup kitchens, food banks, meal programs and other hunger-relief charities in local communities. Over the last three years alone, thousands of groups collected over \$25 million in dollars and food donations.

The mission of the *Souper Bowl of Caring* is to **unite all communities to tackle hunger** with a vision to inspire our youth and to enable them to contribute to the world-wide problem of hunger. This program enables our youth to experience the power of giving to those less fortunate than their families.

Our students will be holding a soup pan as you leave Mass next Sunday and asking for your donation of just \$1 per person to help tackle hunger. Those in need will appreciate any amount that you can give.

Every place of worship should be informed of the needs of people, especially in our own communities. Our parish also participates in giving to the students of Maplewood Elementary School by collecting peanut butter for their weekend backpack program, helping less fortunate children and their families over the weekends and holiday breaks when school lunches are not available. Each year we also fill baskets of food to be given to local families at Christmas time. These projects make us aware of people who are less fortunate than we are and give us the opportunity, in Christian charity, to help those in need.
